Some people find it easy to give hugs and kisses. Others were raised to be more reserved. Among my own children, two always greet me with a kiss and the other two will only hug me if I move first. The tendency to show affection is a real gift. The dying often wish they had given more affection to those they loved.

Jesus obviously loved the gesture of the woman in **today's Gospel. When "she showed great love," Jesus** received that love and he rewarded her. Jesus takes Simon to task for belittling her gesture.

In our day, a gesture of affection can be a priceless gift. Taking time at the door to embrace your spouse and offer a word of encouragement or comfort is important. Pausing to acknowledge our children with a hug as they leave and return home reminds them that our love supports them throughout the day. In those intimate moments, we offer a silent prayer for these precious ones. It may be hard to turn a stoic family into huggers, but it will be worth the effort. I had to push myself to reach out to my awkward teenagers with kisses and hugs, but now, they have returned to my arms with their own **children who can't wait for Grandma's embrace.**

## 11th Sunday in OT

2 Samuel 12:7-10, 13

A prophet pronounces judgment on a sinful king. But repentance leads to forgiveness.

Galatians 2:16, 19-21

Paul underscores the life-giving power of faith in Christ. Having been crucified with Christ in faith and baptism, Paul now has a new life - Christ lives in him.

Luke 7:36-8:3

A woman having had her sins forgiven by Jesus, upsets the host and the guests of a formal **dinner by anointing Jesus' feet** and showing him the honor he did not receive from the host.

1. What does Jesus see in the **woman that Simon doesn't see?**
2. How do you show Jesus love?
3. What did the woman risk in **interrupting the Pharisee's gathering?**
4. What can we learn from this story that we can apply to our lives?
